We are headed for La No Che!

*Please read everything below to **Be Prepared** for this fantastic event!*

Place: Camp La No Che, Paisley, FL

Times:

12/26/10: Meet at FUMCWG @ 4:00 pm Sunday for bus load. All personal gear will be loaded into the bus. Troop Quartermasters and Quartermaster Advisor(s) needed.

12/27/10: Everyone meets at FUMCWG @ 8:00 am in full uniform for travel. **(As always, all Scouts must have compass, whistle and flashlight.)** If you are on time, you are late! Tail lights will be 8:30 am or sooner. Eat breakfast before coming to the Church.

12/30/10: Expect return to FUMCWG @ 3:00 pm; Remember our rule is that no one leaves until all gear is put away and the bus is cleaned. Please plan accordingly.

Equipment: Please bring only 3 bundles. A duffle bag or backpack, sleeping bag and folding camp chair. Make sure that your name is on each bundle. We will be sleeping in the camp tents/lean-to's. Bring warm clothes and closed toe shoes!

Plan & Pack for:

We will be camping in platform tents or lean-to's. We will leave it cleaner than we found it. All meals at camp are included in the price. You must be able to clean up and be ready to leave camp by 1:30 pm.

Depending upon attendance, we will take the bus OR we'll need extra adults to help transport participants in their own vehicles; quantity TBD.

Fees for Campers

1. Fuel fee is \$0 and is included
2. Camping Fee is \$100 per person (includes 3 nights of camping and meals).
3. Each person must bring a **\$100** check written to Troop 210 with the completed permission form by 11/15/10. You can use funds from your troop account (if you have them) for the \$100 IF you notify Mr. Newlon or Mrs. Byers beforehand.
4. Misc fees for individual activities and events.

Other Miscellaneous Notes: No electronic devices (phones, ipods, MP3 players, walkmans, radios, game-boys, etc.) allowed out of the bus. Music and movies on personal players must be Scout-appropriate. Just ask yourself - Would Mr. E. approve of my music/movies? If no, then don't bring it.

Description:

This is a winter Camp offered by the Order of the Arrow Tipisa Lodge Membership to be held at the Central Florida Council's Camp La No Che in Paisley, FL. Activities include merit badges, and other recreational activities. All meals at camp are provided. Various merit badges and activities require additional fees or materials to be purchased at the camp store. This is winter camp so pack accordingly for COLD weather! Most participants also bring about \$5 per day for miscellaneous snacks or other items available at the camp's trading post.
