Sea Base Out Island Adventure

We will be traveling to the Florida Keys in July, 2011 (yes, next year) for the "Out Island Adventure" – a week of fun at BSA's Sea Base. This adventure requires rugged camping skills, because we will be on an island for 4 days! We will kayak in with all of our gear and spend our days snorkeling, fishing and exploring the island's flora and fauna!

The cost for this trip is \$725 per participant, and the gear list is available (as well as additional information) at the Sea Base web site, www.bsaseabase.com. The initial payment will be \$100 for a deposit, another \$325.00 due September 1, 2010 and final payment of \$300 due February 1, 2011.

Space is limited! We have been given two crews, each consisting of 2 adults and up to 6 Scouts. Minimum age restrictions are that you MUST be 14 by September 1, 2011. NO EXCEPTIONS ARE ALLOWED.

We have 15 months until we leave. During that time we will be training, earning merit badges, raising funds and HAVING FUN!

Since space is limited, the PLC has decided that the slots will be on a first come, first served basis. PLEASE do your research at the above listed site PRIOR to making a commitment. Then, return to Mr. Stanford the signed permission slip as well as a check for \$100 as a deposit.

After the maximum trip size is reached, there will be a waiting list. Please contact Mr. Stanford with any questions.
